Call to Order- 7:39 PM

a. A Motion for the Call to Order was Made by Kelly K., Seconded by Linda N.

b. The Motion was unanimously approved.

1. Band Director's Report

a. Monthly Update

i. Indoor Guard

1. KIDA Indoor Guard show at Central Dauphin this weekend
2. Transportation for all guard trips have been approved

ii. Championships 2026

1. Potentially hosting Championships again for outdoor; Cavalcade has asked if we would be willing and able to host again next year
2. Mr. Farkas is working on figuring out whether CV will honor the reduced price again for the stadium/facility usage; if not, Cavalcade will not host at CV because of the cost.

iii. Scholarships for seniors

1. Planning on giving one or two scholarships, depending on the number of applicants
2. Application will likely go out in March, with the intention of presenting it at the May band concert like last year

iv. Varsity letters

1. Mr. Farkas is putting the final touches on the student list of who is eligible and still needs their Varsity letter
2. Students must be in marching band for two years to be eligible for a letter
3. A parent asked if they also get pins for subsequent years of participation like athletic teams; Mr. Farkas isn't aware of that, only letters.

v. Middle school engagement

1. Mr. Farkas is working with Mr. Stahl and Mr. Ocker (Mountain View and Eagle View band directors) to brainstorm ideas on ways to keep middle schoolers excited about and connected to band leading into high



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2. They are working on adding an extra event or two after Bands in the Stands so they can build on the excitement of the event.
3. Planning to do Rookie Camp again in May so that potential members can try out marching band
- vi. Student leadership for next year
 1. Looking at starting leadership interviews next week; sending out a sign up link tomorrow
 2. Wants to be more strict with the selection process based on past experiences
 - a. Specifically, Mr. Farkas wants to make sure that section leaders understand the expectations of the role in terms of leadership, correcting behaviors, setting good examples, representing CV at competitions, etc.
- vii. Band Camp
 1. Hoping to have dates out to students by the end of this week
 - a. Will either be the last two weeks of July or the last week of July and first week of August
 2. School starts late next year so they still have not finalized dates.
- viii. Summer practices
 1. Will run like last year
 - a. One rehearsal a week until July 4
 - b. Not mandatory, but encouraged
 2. After July 4th weekend
 - a. will go to our typical Tuesday and Thursday practices from 6-8:30pm
 - b. Not mandatory, but encouraged
 3. After band camp
 - a. Tuesday and Thursdays from 6-9pm
 - b. Mandatory
