The Band Boosters Board voted to purchase a new truck for towing things like our uniform truck and our fry wagon. We were able to get three years, 36 months of 0% financing. Due to the fact that we have paid cash for everything in the past, our organization did not have credit and therefore we had to put \$10,000 down. The first truck payment will come out in January

Stephanie Sevcik asked if we received a check from the guard clothing sale yet. Walt said that we have not yet. Stephanie said that this check will be a little over \$200 coming in. He will keep her posted about the progress.

## **Trunk or Treat:**

As a replacement for the traditional Halloween party we hold, there will be a Trunk or Treat on October 29 at the end of rehearsal. If it rains, we'll have to look at the 31st or the following week.

Kendra sent a sign-up sheet in email so please check there for opportunities to get involved and make this a fun night for the kids. Parents' cars will be socially distanced around the parking lot with the back of the cars themed. Each section will start at a different place at Trunk or Treat and move in one direction so that all the distancing is maintained. Students can vote for best parent display and best costume. This will be accomplished via a QR code.

Chandra has gloves to give to everyone. Please remember that if you are handing anything out to the kids you must have gloves. Masks must also be worn.

## **Upcoming Events:**

We also have the option of having a food truck like one from Vissagio's cater the event. Jen will continue to work on this and keep us updated.

### **Show Shirts and Apparel:**
