Call to Order- 7:33 PM

- a. A Motion for the Call to Order was Made by Kelly K. and was Seconded by Linda N.
- b. The Motion was unanimously approved.
- 1. Band Director's Report
 - a. Notes from Farkas
 - i. Rookie Camps
 - 1. Band
 - a. Begins after the spring band concert on May 13
 - b. Will be held on May 20, 22, 27 from 6:00-8:00PM
 - c. It will not be held on May 29 as originally intended because the Orchestra concert was moved to this date.
 - d. Nicky G. is hoping to have a parent meeting during one of the camps to connect with new parents
 - e. Rookie camp is intended for new members but returning members are welcome to come
 - f. Section leaders are required to attend
 - 2. Color Guard
 - a. Color guard clinics will held for new members that are interested in outdoor or indoor guard (indoor guard can include middle schoolers)
 - b. Begins April 29 and will be held in the spectator gym color guard clinics for new members for outdoor (or indoor middle schoolers)
 - 3. Drumline clinics will begin May 6
 - a. includes drumline and front ensemble
 - b. hoping clinics will help them get an early start and hopefully increase numbers for next year
 - 4. Mr. Farkas sent out the information for clinics to EV and MV directors



- ii. Summer rehearsals
 - 1. Thursday rehearsals will start on June 19 from 6-8:30PM
 - 2. No rehearsal on July 3
 - 3. After July 3, rehearsals will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6-8:30PM
 - 4. Participation for summer rehearsals are voluntary but highly encouraged

iii. Band Camp

- 1. Will be held July 28-August 8, 2025
- 2. Times of camp
 - a. 1-9PM Monday-Thursday
 - b. 9AM-12:30PM Fridays
- iv. After school starts, rehearsals will return to the normal Tuesday/Thursday schedule
- v. Echoes in the Valley
 - 1. 4 bands currently signed up
 - 2. Calvalcade added an extra competition that day for US Bands so that is likely negatively impacting our numbers
 - 3. Numbers are low for all of the other shows that day too
 - 4. We will wait and see the numbers registered at Band Camp to make a decision but could end up cancelling it
 - 5. If cancelled, we would pick up another show
- vi. Marching Band 2025
 - 1. There are currently 70 plus members registered
 - 2. Mr. Farkas believes there are likely a fair amount who have no registered yet
 - 3. Still working on the 2025 theme; not quite ready to announce though drum majors have been told
 - 4. The goal is to have at least 3 movements written by band camp to work on
