

C.V.B.B. General Meeting Minutes – August 11, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. There were approximately 52 people in attendance. The minutes from June's general meeting were approved with no changes.

Treasurer's Report:

Gerry Balz presented the treasurer's report. It looks like revenues will be a challenge this year. To date, every event has been down from last year's figures. We also only have 5 home games this season and we will not be hosting Chapters. There is approximately \$19,100 in the student accounts. The profit loss statement is skewed right now because we have paid out for items and have not had much opportunity for fundraising so far this season.

The vinyl was purchased to cover the bleachers. It is red. It needs to be cut to fit the bleachers.

A question was asked about if party fees could be paid for out of student accounts. The consensus was that it would take too much administrative red tape to do that.

The trivia question for the evening was "Which actress played Lily Munster on The Munsters?"

A motion to approve the Treasurer's report was made, seconded and approved.

Old Business:

The Student Directory is finished. It should be available by the end of band camp. The schedule for competitions is on the website.

An e-mail will be sent out regarding Parent preview night with a list of what each section should bring for the dinner. The location will be announced later this week.

New Business:

Phil reported that he and Mr. Ainscough are working on a date to go over the contracts. We are submitting eight contracts to the school district for payment. This will be for next year. We are also asking them to pay for all mandatory items. The district has been asked to pick up two contracted positions immediately. This will really help with our funds if the district picks up some of the salary costs that have been paid out of CVBB funds previously.

Phil wished to acknowledge all of Gerry's hard work in streamlining and overseeing the CVBB accounts.

We are getting the new banner soon. It will probably not be available for Parent preview Night.

Senior Night will be October 9, 2009.

Fry Wagon/Uniforms:
