11 April 201

Meeting was called to order by President, Jere Engelman at 7:03. There were 24 people in attendance.

Motion made, seconded and passed to accept the March meeting minutes as accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Year to Date Loss of \$10,203 which does not include the Denny's fundraiser. There is \$10,500 dollars in student accounts. We have the second half of the indoor staff payments due this month but we also have the indoor show so we are hoping that we will catch up to where we normally are this time of the year.

We are currently running a hanging basket fundraiser and the forms are on the website.

April 25 and April 27 will be the new parent orientation meetings. We will have a new parent orientation at the May booster meeting. The theme for next year's marching band show will be Aaron Copland music.

We have a new guard director for next year - Josh Baugher. We won't know the size of the band until May.

We have 11 applicants for the band scholarship which are being reviewed and the scholarships will be awarded at the next band concert.

Fundraising Chair Steven Weir – we made \$459 dollars at the Denny's fundraiser. We made \$115 at the Five Guys fundraiser. The Isaac's fundraiser is Thursday Apr 21st, you need to bring the flyer and it runs all day. Wednesday, May 4th is a Chili's fundraiser and it is an all day fundraiser.
