

## CVBB General Meeting Minutes

9 December 2013

The meeting was called to order by Kelley LeVan at 6:30 pm. There were approximately 40 members in attendance.

A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the **November 2013** minutes as stated. (*The minutes from the previous meetings are posted on the website in "draft" form so everyone can view them. Upon approval, a "final" version will be posted over the draft form.*)

### Treasurer's Report – Dominic Sherony

Balance to date is \$6,200. There are some outstanding checks not shown in the statement. There is approximately \$21,384 in student accounts.

Income:

- Concessions for last few football games: \$17,000 gross
- Bingo brought in about \$2,400
- Wreath sale brought in about \$348
- Competition ticket sales brought in about \$300

Expenses:

- 2012 audit and tax return - \$4,950.
- Staff salaries - \$6,925.

A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the Treasurer's report, as stated.

### Director's Report

- **District band** - Scott Ainscough reports that 20 students made District band. Aaron Keister and Jessica Lynch both made first chair. Congratulations to both of these students!
- **Indoor Drum line and Guard** - practicing now.

- **Jazz band** - begins after Christmas.
- **Echoes in the Dome** - registration is open; event is scheduled for March 29, 2014.
- **Band room clean up** - band room purge from 9:00 to 4:00 on December 23<sup>rd</sup> & December 27<sup>th</sup>.
- **Questions from parents:** Dave was asked for feedback on the change from TOB to COB. He said that he feels the decision was the best one for the band. The students were given more feedback on performances and he feels the level of competition was better. He stated that this is the first season in all of his years of marching band that is truly sorry to see the season end. He was also proud of the fact that the bands final performance was their best of the season and that was his goal for the year. The only negative is the lack of "local" competition.
