

## C.V.B.B. General Meeting – December 14, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. there were approximately 32 people in attendance.

A motion was made, seconded and approved to accept the November minutes with no changes.

Phil McCormick welcomed everyone to the meeting. He explained that new officers for the upcoming year were going to be voted in. He expressed thanks to the outgoing officers for their time and efforts.

**Treasurer's Report:** Gerry Balz reported that we ended the season \$7,600.00 in the black. This is very good since we have been ending up in the red the last several years. We need to purchase a new drum major platform and storage for the home field practice area but we are holding off on other discretionary items. Decisions about what other items may be purchased will be made in February.

Student accounts are available for review. Students are able to use the money from their student accounts to pay for banquet tickets for themselves and family members.

The trivia question was based on the spreadsheet that Mr. Ainscough sent out in June. What were the percentages of Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors? Answer 23 seniors, making up 16.7%, 28 juniors making up 19%, 59 sophomores making up 41% and 33 freshmen making up 23%.

A motion was made, seconded and approved to accept the treasurer's report as presented.

### **Committee Reports:**

Ann French wanted to commend and acknowledge Phil McCormick and Gerry Balz for all of the time, effort and energy that they have put in to the band boosters this past season. Many improvements and changes have been accomplished because of their hard work and dedication.

Carri Kunkle announced that the Band Banquet will be held on Saturday, January 23<sup>rd</sup> at 5:30 p.m. at the Radisson Penn Harris. Invitations and more information will be sent out after the Christmas break. It will be a plated dinner this year so responses must be turned in on time. Students will be allowed to send two free grams, more can be purchased at \$1.00 each. Volunteers are needed to help take the orders for the grams. They would like to have another gift card giveaway. Donations of \$10.00 gift cards can be turned in to anyone on the committee or put in the band box with a note.

There is a dress code for the banquet and the students will not be permitted to change clothes.

The cost for the banquet is \$25.00 for adults, \$20.00 for students and \$15.00 each for children 10 and under.

Teresa Eckard announced that there will be an e-mail coming out requesting help with flag sewing for the indoor show. The first competition is the last Saturday in January.

**Elections:**
