

CVBB General Meeting Minutes

10 April 2012

The meeting was called to order at **7:05 pm** by Jere Engelman. There were 27 members in attendance.

A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the **March 2012** meeting minutes.

Treasurer's Report – Dominic Sherony

- Loss to date is approximately \$7,000.
- Student accounts currently have \$21,000.
- Pizza sale brought in about \$1,800 profit.
- A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the Treasurer's report, as stated.

Band Director's Report

- Jazz bands are going to the Boiling Springs Music Festival this weekend.
- Next season's show theme will be "Among the Clouds" with music from *Peter Pan* and *How to Train Your Dragon*. Working on visual ideas, including several clouds. Would like to have the props mostly finished for band camp in August.
- Indoor program is going well; next Saturday, April 21st will be the next competition. Echoes in the Dome still needs volunteers; please contact Andrew Rucker if you are available.
- "Try out Marching Band Day" is Saturday April 14th in the band room. The band specifically needs trumpet players for next year.

President's Report – Jere Engelman:

- Application for seniors for a CVBB scholarships; these are made available to seniors each year. Deadline to submit an application is today, April 10th.
- Echoes in the Dome/Andrew Rucker - still looking for volunteers for April 28th. Please contact Andrew Rucker if you can help in any way, even for a short time. Forms are on the website if anyone is interested. Baked goods donations are needed to sell during the competition.
- *Echoes in the Valley* is October 6th. A mass email went out to all bands and we have five bands signed up so far. The facilities are reserved.
- Wildwood/John Tallman – buses will leave at 7:00 am Thursday morning. The balance for payment is due April 20th. Please confirm your reservations with John before the trip. The reservations are for "The Crystal Sands" and "The Newport Beach." More detailed information is available on the website.
- Disney trip/Jere Engelman – no new information on the trip. We currently have 14 chaperones; still need a few more. There will be an option for family members to stay in the same hotel and get the same deals as the students, if one parent is a chaperone.
- "Celebrate CV" Day is scheduled for Sunday June 3rd. As part of this event, all boosters' organizations are invited to set up booths to raise additional funds. We are planning to set up the Fry Wagon and a "ball throw into a sousaphone" booth. We will need volunteers to help with the booths. It was discussed to have a booth to make buttons but we need someone to help with this as well. There is software available for this but we would need to purchase it. If anyone is interested in designing buttons, please contact Bev Uniacke. Also discussed snow cones, fried onion rings, and drinks. Jere will check with the CV Board to see if any of these ideas are available.

- Jim Richey produced a DVD of four shows from last year. Jere has copies available now for \$5.00.
- Dana Kruger started the hanging flower basket sale today. Sale goes through April 30th and delivery is May 11th. Dana needs volunteers to help unload the flowers the day of delivery.
- Sheri is working on a sandwich sale for June during mini band camp.
- Discussed issues concerning new parent information. Jere will ask Dave if he is planning on having a New Parent orientation meeting to give them the information they need for fundraising, etc.
- There is a vacancy for the restaurant fundraiser organization, props coordinator, concession food prep and others. If you are interested in any of these areas, please let Jere know.
- Discussed selling movie theatre ticket books. Maria Einolf will look into this for one of the student fundraisers, possibly in June.
- Kelly Smith is setting up mentors for incoming students. Please let her know if you are willing to be a mentor for new parents/students.
- Website issues are fixed.
