

CVBB General Meeting, May 10, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:45 by Phil McCormick, there were approximately 35 people in attendance.

A motion was made and carried to accept the April meeting minutes as written.

New Business:

Band Trip: We are going on a trip. Several folks are gathering information and we have narrowed it down to 2 places: San Antonio or Tampa. The reason for the delay is the December airfare has not yet been published. The timeframe is the same: 4 or 5 night trip between Christmas and New Year's and the band will be performing at a bowl game. We do not want the price to exceed the 2008 Disney trip which was around \$1300. We will let you know as soon as a decision is made.

Macy's Thanksgiving Day parade: Phil contacted them and they are filled up until 2012. The applications come out in January and we will submit an application in case the band wants to go in 2012.

Extra Duty staff contracts: The district is not picking up any new extra duty staff contracts this year for any organization. That means that we pay the staff contracts this year. The Band Director's are working on their staff requirements and will let the boosters know their requirements in the next few weeks. We are working on streamlining the positions/salaries. The Band Director's do not sign the staff contracts; the band boosters do. We are following the school district's policy on security clearances; any person working with the marching band must have their clearances 30 days after the contract is signed.

Treasurer's Report: Year to date we have a \$7200 loss; this is less than where we were at this time last year. Student account balances total \$31,216.00. A motion was made and carried to approve the Treasurer's report.

Band Director's Report: Mr. Porter reported that due to finals, the Monday, June 7 rehearsal has been moved to Tuesday, June 8. June rehearsals are June 1, 8 and 10. The show theme this year is "Russia". Ninth and Tenth grade practices are May 24 and 27. Marching band Student leaders have been assigned this year and are already beginning to meet. We will have 3 drum majors this year.

On July 6 there is a DCI Drum Corp show at Chambersburg and we are hosting one of the corps, Phantom Regiment, at CV. Our students will get to watch their rehearsal and some students may get to work with their staff. We will need band booster volunteers to assist on that day. Every student that comes to a portion of that day will get a free ticket to the evening performance.

Fry Wagon: First outing is this Friday at Middlesex Elementary and Nancy needs two more volunteers.
