

CVBB General Meeting 14 March 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:00. There were approximately 24 persons in attendance.

Motion made, seconded and passed to approve the February meeting minutes as written.

Treasurer's Report: \$11,540 in the hole this year so far.

Scholarship applications are due April 8th.

Website – Gerry posts the indoor scores every Sunday. He made a page for the Wildwood Trip and has updated the scheduled fundraisers. Many people are asking about the marching band schedule for next year; Mr. Porter has been selected as the band director and he has not given Gerry a schedule yet. Motion made, seconded and passed to approve the Treasurer's report.

Fundraising Chairman: Steve Weir has started setting up the restaurant fundraisers. He is aiming for 2 a month; First Tuesday and Third Thursday. Steve has flyers for the Denny's fundraiser on March 24th. This is a 24 hour fundraiser. April 5th will be Five Guys and Thursday April 21st will be Isaac's. April 21st is a teacher in-service day so Isaac's will give us 25% for the whole day. Steve needs volunteers to handle the student fundraisers. Steve has the information and all of the paperwork for running a fundraiser.

Echoes in the Dome: Gary Calaman. Indoor percussion is doing really well this year. The key chairperson committees are filled; we just need lots of volunteers. We don't have a schedule from TIA yet. Gary is going to send emails to the units this week to determine who will be attending. Program information is due on Friday. There will be a planning meeting next week.

Wildwood Trip: Indoor guard/drumline will be going on the trip. \$150.00 deposit is due tonight. We are taking a charter bus and we are floating between 48 and 50 students going on the trip; leaving 4-6 chaperones on the bus. Chaperones must have current clearances. Price to ride the bus is \$295.00. We will be providing the meals. For those not riding the bus the price is \$195.00. Jon Tallman will send out emails when he gets more information.

Echoes in the Valley are scheduled for Oct 15th. Chapters are the week following that. We do not know if we will be hosting Chapters for the Outdoor season.
