

CVBB General Meeting Minutes

8 October 2012

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm. There were approximately 40 members in attendance.

A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the **September 2012** minutes as stated.

Treasurer's Report - Dominic Sherony

- Loss to date is ~ \$8,200. This does not include the Joe Corbi's fundraiser or proceeds from Echoes in the Valley. We still have a few more football games to bring in funds, as well.
- "Echoes" was successful; good weather and a good turnout. We brought in over \$11,000 in gross receipts.
- Student accounts currently have ~ \$21,790.
- Annual audit fee was paid \$4,900
- A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the Treasurer's report, as stated.

President's Report

- There is no competition this Saturday. Practice will be 9:00 am – 3:00 pm.
- Joe Corbi's pizza delivered this Thursday. Parents can pick up their orders when they drop off their kids.
- **Christmas Wreath sale** – November fundraiser. Wreaths sell for \$25, with \$4 going toward the student's account and \$1 going to the general fund. Orders are due October 26th; please make out one check to CVBB. Delivery will be Thursday November 29th after school.
- **Band banquet** - reservations are due November 30th. Fee for band members is \$20, adults are \$25 and children under ten are \$15. Invitations will go out November 12th. Money from students' accounts can be used to pay for the whole family. The banquet will be held on Friday January 4th at the Radisson Penn Harris Hotel in Camp Hill. More information will be coming out later.
- **Butter braids** - fundraiser will be in December. More details will be coming later.
- It was noted that student accounts will keep rolling over each year until the student graduates. At this point, funds can be reallocated to a sibling or another band member. If not specified, money from the account will be rolled into the general fund.
- Game this Friday against Mifflin County; we still need help in concessions. Please go to the CVBB website to sign up for any game.
- **Senior night** - is Friday October 26th. Michele Pezzuti will organize the event but cannot attend that evening. We are looking for someone to help Michele and handle logistics for that evening. Please let Jere know if you are able to help that night.
- **Chapters** will be Saturday October 20th, in Mechanicsburg. This is our local chapter championships. Our placement there will determine our play time at ACCs in Hershey.
- **ACCs** – final competition of the year is Sunday October 28th. We will play some time in the morning. Tickets will be available through CVBB before the competition: \$20 for adults and \$15 for students/seniors, with \$3 going into our general fund. Tickets at the gate will be \$22 and \$17. We will know a performance time after Chapters. We usually have a "send off" committee of parents to line up at the dock when they get on the buses. Picnic afterward at the school around 2:00 pm in the cafeteria. Pizza and subs will be provided and all parents are asked to bring a side dish; a list will come out explaining this.
- **Mechanicsburg parade** - tomorrow night; band students should report to the school at 5:00 pm and should return around 9:30 pm. They will change into uniforms at the school and ride buses to Mechanicsburg. The route is on their website. There is a house that the kids will stop in front of to perform and parents are welcome to come watch them.
- **Band Halloween Party** - Thursday October 25th (final Thursday rehearsal) in the hallway outside the band room. Parents bring in snacks and drinks. Practice will end a little early and students are encouraged to dress up in costumes. Prizes will be given to those who dress up. More information will come out on the website about this, along with a request for snacks. Theda Tallman and Kelley LeVan will organize this event.

- **Disney trip** – final payment is due next Thursday October 18th. There will be a meeting for students and parents before the trip so everyone understands the expectations and details, following the next booster meeting.
- **Rehearsals** - after ACCs, there will be periodic rehearsals as announced by Mr. Porter, probably Monday nights.
- **Willow Mill Park Festival** - Nobody has volunteered to head this up so we will not take the fry wagon to this event. We are still looking for someone to be in charge of Non-stadium events for the fry wagon.
- **Restaurant Nights** – Wednesday October 10th at Texas Roadhouse; 10% of proceeds will go into the general fund. Tuesday November 6th at Isaacs.
- **Nomination Committee** – Stacey Griffiths will head this up. We have many vacant positions coming up for next year and we need volunteers to step up and fill these. Please consider volunteering your time to help the boosters.
