

## CVBB General Meeting Minutes

**14 October 2013**

The meeting was called to order by Kelley LeVan at 6:30 pm. There were approximately 30 members in attendance.

A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the **September 2013** minutes as stated. (*The minutes from the previous meetings are posted on the website in "draft" form so everyone can view them. Upon approval, a "final" version will be posted over the draft form.*)

### Treasurer's Report – Dominic Sherony

Balance to date is \$11,491.37. There is approximately \$17,519 in student accounts.

Income:

- General fundraisers brought in about \$3,800
- Competition ticket sales \$600
- Credit card cashback \$786
- Fry wagon events \$478

Expenses:

- Concessions \$12,000
- Outdoor program salaries \$5,700
- Outdoor props \$800
- Administration \$2,400

A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the Treasurer's report, as stated.

### President's Report

#### ➤ **Fundraisers:**

- **Mechanicsburg Flea Market** plans are under way. We have had a lot of donations offered. Any donations should be dropped off at Barb Goodrich's house Friday night. She will be looking for volunteers soon to help with the day's events. The Flea Market will be held from 7:00 to 1:00 on Sunday October 20th at the Mechanicsburg Club.
- **Basket Bingo** – will be held here at the high school, November 17<sup>th</sup>. Robin Zampelli will take care of volunteers, Selena Culwell is in charge of food, Barb Goodrich will look for sponsors. Drum line will provide volunteer help for the day. Maria placed an order for baskets but she will be ordering more closer to the date. We will be looking for more sponsors: if anybody has ideas for partial or full sponsorship please let Barb know ASAP. We have the cafeteria reserved from 11:00 to 5:00 on November 17th. All profits will go into the general fund. It has been difficult getting sponsors – any help would be appreciated. It was suggested that Dave Porter send out a mass email to the school promoting the bingo. Maria will send flyers out as soon as they are available.
- **Wreath Sale** – flyers are available now and orders are due Monday November 4<sup>th</sup> with delivery on Monday Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup>. Wreaths are \$30. \$8.00 goes into the student account for each wreath.
- **Butterbraids** – fundraiser for December/Kelly Smith.
- **Car Show**/fundraiser for Indoor Season – this will be held in May. Several parents have offered to help with this event. The event would be held here at the school.

- Wearing uniforms after the performance at competitions – there has been concern about the kids’ behavior at the event; discussion about the difficulty of keeping the kids quiet for other bands.
- Price adjustments were made in the concession stand for the next game to help cover rising costs.
- Concessions – still looking for volunteers for the concession stand for football games. If anyone knows other parents who would like to help, please let Dominic know.
- Friday night’s game: we play Central Dauphin this Friday (homecoming) and State College at home on November 1<sup>st</sup>. (senior night)
- Echoes Competition; discussion about ways to make up for the financial loss of not having a home event. We will host the indoor show in the spring.
- “Igive.com” – an online shopping site – you can register there and select the CV marching band as your charity and a % of your purchase will be donated to the band. More information will be coming out to explain this site.
- Halloween party – Shelly Maffee, Terry Sollenberger, Jill Ahrens & Wendy Bopp are planning the party. There will be an email sent out to the band boosters requesting food and gift cards. The kids can dress up in costume and there will be prizes for each winning costume.
- Board openings for 2014: if anyone is interested in a position on the CVBB board, please let Janet know as soon as possible.
- Trip – discussion about planning the next trip.
- Cavalcade – discussion about the decision to move to Cavalcade and the quality of bands that perform at the shows.
- Band banquet - there will be a meeting right after the boosters’ meeting tonight.
- October 24<sup>th</sup> and November 8<sup>th</sup> - delivery of tshirts – order forms will be sent out on via email.
